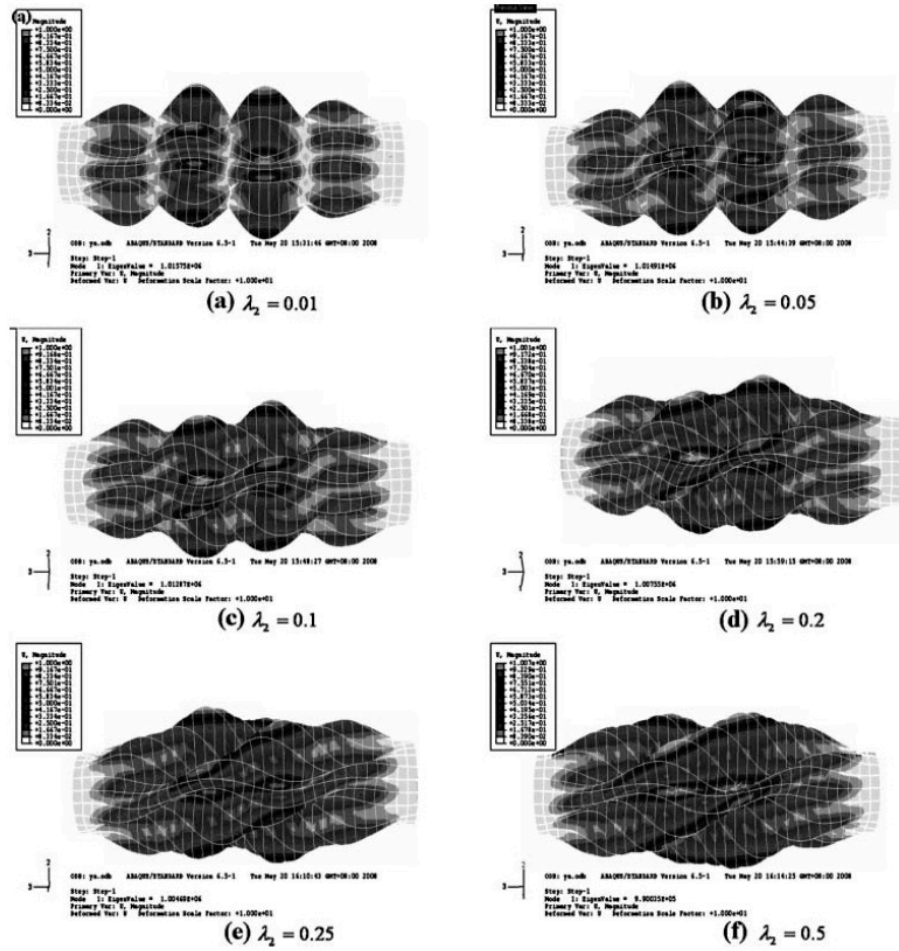


FIG. 8. Buckling modes of FGCSs under ATCC ($N = 1, l = 1m, R = 0.1m, h = 1mm$).
